

The GMAT/GRE test

All QTEM candidates must send an official score of GMAT or of GRE to QTEM. Candidates cannot be admitted to the QTEM network without an official score.

What is GMAT?

The **Graduate Management Admission Test** (**GMAT**) is a computer adaptive test intended to assess certain analytical, writing, quantitative, verbal, and reading skills for use in admission to a graduate management program. Answering the test questions requires knowledge of English grammatical rules, reading comprehension, and mathematical skills.

GMAT assesses analytical writing and problem-solving abilities while also addressing data sufficiency, logic, and critical reasoning skills, all considered as vital to real-world business and management success. By taking the GMAT, you demonstrate this managerial abilities using an international standard praised by shools and corporations.

The Graduate Management Admission Council (GMAC) owns and operates the test.

The GRE alternative

The GRE revised General Test is also accepted for QTEM, as an alternative to the GMAT test.

The Graduate Record Examinations (GRE) is a standardized test that is an admissions requirement for many graduate schools. It measures verbal reasoning, quantitative reasoning, analytical writing, and critical thinking skills that have been acquired over a long period of learning.

The GRE is owned and administered by Educational Testing Service (ETS).
