

## The GMAT/GRE test

All QTEM candidates must send an official score of GMAT or of GRE to QTEM. Candidates cannot be admitted to the QTEM network without an official score.

### *What is GMAT?*

The **Graduate Management Admission Test (GMAT)** is a computer adaptive test intended to assess certain analytical, writing, quantitative, verbal, and reading skills for use in admission to a graduate management program. Answering the test questions requires knowledge of English grammatical rules, reading comprehension, and mathematical skills.

GMAT assesses analytical writing and problem-solving abilities while also addressing data sufficiency, logic, and critical reasoning skills, all considered as vital to real-world business and management success. By taking the GMAT, you demonstrate these managerial abilities using an international standard praised by schools and corporations.

The Graduate Management Admission Council ([GMAC](#)) owns and operates the test.

### *The GRE alternative*

The GRE revised General Test is also accepted for QTEM, as an alternative to the GMAT test.

The Graduate Record Examinations (GRE) is a standardized test that is an admissions requirement for many graduate schools. It measures verbal reasoning, quantitative reasoning, analytical writing, and critical thinking skills that have been acquired over a long period of learning.

The GRE is owned and administered by Educational Testing Service ([ETS](#)).
